

Taos Farmers' Market 2013 Bakery Vendor Application

Thank you for your interest in having a bakery booth at the Taos Farmers' Market. The purpose of having bakers at the market is to provide customers with a more complete shopping experience, making it easier for farmers to sell their produce, as well as to provide shoppers with healthful, homemade products made with quality, local ingredients. **Bakers should be willing to commit to having a booth at the Market for the entire season (25 markets)**, as it is important for us to fill out the market 'shoulder seasons' of May & June and October when there is less produce available. *As always, the goal of the Market is to provide a locally-grown, healthy food supply!*

This year we will select seven applicants to sell baked goods at the Market. Priority will be given to applicants who **prioritize the use of local, organic ingredients**. Baked goods must come from a certified kitchen.

Application deadline is April 1, 2013. You will be notified by **April 13, 2013**, if you have been approved to sell for the 2013 Market season.

The ideal candidate would:

Use locally produced, organic ingredients

Attend all 25 markets, from May 11 to October 26, 2013, 8:00am-1:00pm weekly

Package products appropriately to protect from sun, dust and insects

Be familiar with our Market, having been a regular shopper or vendor in the past

Have prominent signage listing items for sale, prices and local ingredients

Create a booth which would be an attractive addition to the look and feel of the Market

Required: Bake products in a certified kitchen (Please provide documentation with application)

Required: Comply with all health and licensing regulations
